Dr. Wright states, "As a young girl, I not only remember playing dress-up with my sister, but I also remember many days in my father's workshop, exploring my curiosity with science and technology. As a child, I would spend hours testing television tubes and watching my dad fix electronics. Today, I have transferred these childhood fascinations into the world of medicine, aesthetics and skincare."

The biggest challenge today in the cosmetic field has been the move from invasive lasers to less invasive techniques, and deciding what works from what doesn't. Dr. Wright explains, "There is an explosion of technologies, but one has to be careful. Just because something is new doesn't mean that it is necessarily going to work." Lucky for Dr. Wright, she not only has her own expertise to evaluate these machines but also that of her husband. Before pursuing his present career in optometry, Dr. Tim Wright O.D., first graduated with a degree in Electrical Engineering—which has proved invaluable when assessing the performance of the many lasers that are now on the market. That, combined with his recognized artistic talents in facial rejuvenation, has created the perfect combination for providing the most effective and natural-looking results for their patients.

Together, both comment that, "First and foremost we are a medical practice and although we do aesthetics, at the core of it all, it is all about patient



care and comfort." Although in practice for 16 years, in 2007, Dr. Fiona Wright dedicated her skills exclusively to non-surgical cosmetic dermatology and *Skin MD and Beyond* opened its doors. Their clinic looks more like a home than a medical office, and that is intentional. Dr. Tim Wright comments, "People don't get that sterile, white-coat feeling when they come in. The entire atmosphere is inviting and warm—its very soothing and both staff and patients love it."

"Tim and I were honored to be asked to be ambassadors for this year's Golf Invitational and to be part of a charity that does so much for the children of our community. TEAM 22 program sent underserved children to three weeks of summer camp at Camp Champions in Marble Falls, TX, and offered them other unique experiences that they would not otherwise have access to," remarks Dr. Wright.

Of the many charities that have been mentioned, one holds a special interest to the Wrights-City House. In 1987, two Plano ISD teachers founded the program to create a community organization which provides a nurturing and safe environment for children who need emergency care. In 2009, they opened My Friend's House to provide shelter to children up to 17. Star Children's Charity has been actively raising funds for City House to help construct a Children's Bedroom Wing for children ages newborn to nine, who have been removed from their home due to abuse, neglect, and abandonment. "Family is extremely important to us, and Tim and I are blessed to have a healthy and happy family-and we feel it is important to help those that need it," states Dr. Fiona Wright. "As well, it is important for everyone to feel safe and comfortable in their environment. Our clinic offers that to our patients and the CACCC and City House offer it to the children of Collin County." ®
